The Daily Sun, dated Saturday, November 28, 1889, stating she attended Branciforte and Mission Hill School, graduating in the class of 1887. Miss Gilbert stated that "she is fond of domestic life and enjoys learning to keep house."

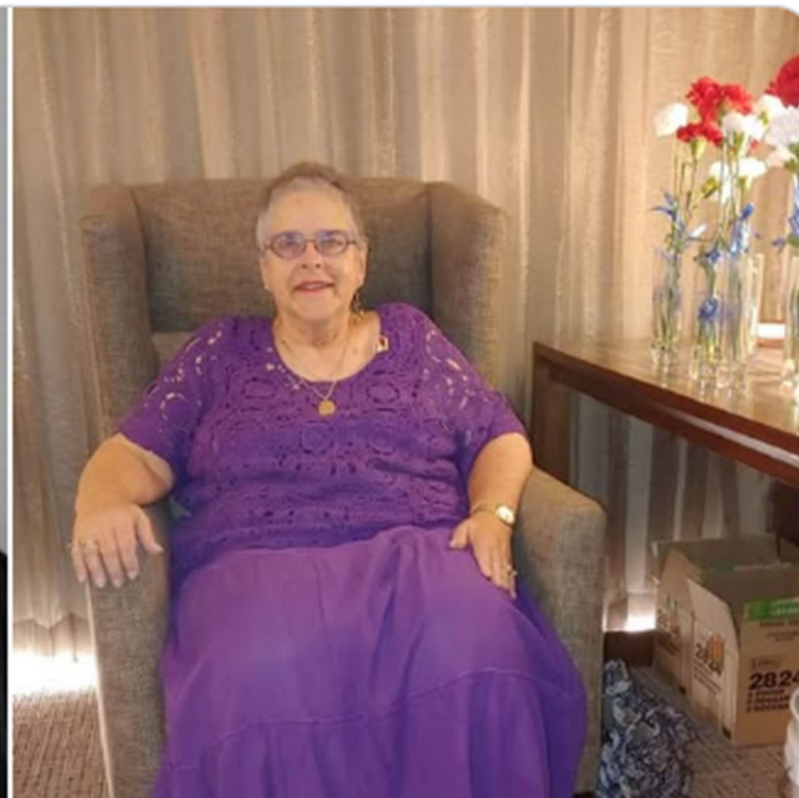
